## THE CURSILLO EXPERIENCE...

I am fond of telling a story that a priest told me several years ago when he was curate at a parish in the Bronx. A man who was a lector at a Mass one Sunday stood up to deliver the announcements and he read, "The Cardinal is against abortion and enthusiasm." Well, actually, what he meant to say was "euthanasia" which is quite a different thing!

Certainly, the Catholic Church is not against enthusiasm - far from it. That word "enthusiasm" is an interesting one. It really means "to be filled with God." The Church encourages everyone to be "filled with God" and certainly more enthusiastic about their faith.

This October, we commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the Second Vatican Council. It was this council that encouraged lay people to be "pro-active" in the living out of their faith. For instance, in the Dogmatic Constitution of the Church (*Lumen Gentium*) we read these words: "Lay people are called by God...By the witness of their life, resplendent in faith, hope and charity, they must manifest Christ to others."

What these words mean simply is that not only the priests and religious have a vocation to holiness. Rather everyone who is baptized is called to live a life that should witness to Jesus Christ and His Gospel. This is not such an easy thing in the world today that is in so much opposition to the Lord and His Good News.

One movement that has risen in the Church in the last few years and that helps Catholics to live the faith in a deeper, more enthusiastic way is called "The Cursillo Movement."



The Cursillo Movement started in Spain back in the 1940's. The word "cursillo" actually means "little course" of Christianity.

The Cursillo aims at giving the participants a new vision of how to practice their faith in our twenty-first century world. It teaches Catholics

how to bring their leadership skills to help Christianize our society. The end result is a wonderful weekend experience which begins on a Thursday night and concludes by a Sunday evening. As a participant, you are not in isolation but join with other devoted Christian disciples who want to know, love and serve Jesus better.

Although I have not made a Cursillo because of the press of parish duties here, I am told that it is an amazing weekend which has to be experienced in order to understand it. One of the great objectives of the movement is that adult Christians come to realize more fully their role as disciples in the world today and their special mission to be messengers of the Gospel.

Two parishioners here at Sacred Heart who are very enthusiastic promoters of the Cursillo Movement are Regina Torello and Bob Morris. Both have felt that the Cursillo Movement has changed their lives in an overwhelmingly positive way.

The Cursillo weekends are offered at Mount Saint Francis which is in Peekskill, New York. The next men's weekend will be held on October 25<sup>th</sup>- October 28<sup>th</sup> and the women's weekend will be conducted from November 1- 4<sup>th</sup>. Transportation to and from the weekend will be provided for anyone who would like to go.

If you are interested in the Cursillo and interested in a more enthusiastic living out of your Catholic Christian faith, why not give it a try?
