

Profession of Faith

A Note from The Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The readings today focus on the concept of repentance. The Lord Jesus Christ, blessed be His Name, summarized the mission statement of His Holy Catholic Church shortly after His Resurrection from the dead. He said: Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. (St. Luke 24:46-48).

In the history of the Church, we've seen great sinners miraculously transformed into great saints. That is the power of God's Grace! St. Longinus was the first century Roman centurion who was assigned to guard the city of Jerusalem during the Passover celebration that marked the end of our Redeemer's life. It fell to him to carry out the execution of our Lord on the Cross. He stabbed Jesus' body with his spear to confirm that Christ was truly dead. Having witnessed the way in which Jesus had died, he cried out: Truly this man was the Son of God! (St. Mark 15:39). It is said that Longinus was converted at that very moment. After being baptized, he became a very effective evangelist. spreading faith in the One whom he had helped to murder.

St. Mary of Egypt (344-421) was a nymphomaniac. She once made a trip to the Holy Land for the sake of seducing the pilgrims on the way. During the trip Mary was suddenly struck with the conviction of just how very wicked she was. She repented and retired to the desert as a hermit. She is especially popular among Eastern-Rite Catholics.

Also popular in the Church of the East is St. Olga of Kiev (d. 969). She was a mass murderer. Queen of the Kievan Rus', she defended her crown by murdering her enemies. Once, she attacked a city and burned it to the ground, even after the inhabitants had surrendered. Eventually she was baptized and the effects of the Sacrament were astonishing. She spent the rest of her life trying to atone for the damage she had done to others. She invited Catholic missionaries to her country, but their work bore little fruit. After Olga's death, however, her intercession brought about the miraculous healing of her grandson, St. Vladimir the Great, who brought the Russian people to Christ.

St. Bruno Sserunkuuma of Üganda was an arrogant, violent, lustful man with a drinking problem. He took two wives and soon one of the women was pregnant. Mercifully, Sserunkuuma's friends St. Charles Lwanga and St. Andrew Kaggwa

demonstrated the power of fraternal correction. They confronted him and, as a result, Sserunkuuma separated from both women. He repented and lived in solitude and prayer. When the persecution of Christians began, he confessed that he was a Christian and was burned to death in 1886. Before perishing Bruno spoke to three other Christians who had been pardoned by the king (kabaka) and said, "Children, I am very sorry for you. I am very much afraid that the kabaka and his creatures will try again to make you renounce Jesus. It would have been better for us all to die, and so reach Heaven together."

Blessed Bartolo Longo (1841-1926) was a high priest of Satan before his conversion. Though raised praying the Rosary, Bartolo went to college where he was exposed to anticlericalism, atheism, and the occult. Before long he was "ordained" a priest of the Prince of Darkness. Bartolo finally renounced Satanism and returned to God. It took some time for him to believe and accept that God had truly forgiven him. For more than 50 years after that, Bartolo preached the Rosary, founded schools for the poor, and established orphanages for the children of criminals. His influence is found especially at the Basilica of Our Lady of Pompeii in Pompeii, Italy, which he himself commissioned. 
