Brothers and sisters: Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen. Because of it the ancients were well attested. By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; he went out, not knowing where he was to go. By faith he sojourned in the promised land as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, heirs of the same promise; for he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and maker is God. By faith he received power to generate, even though he was past the normal age—and Sarah herself was sterile—for he thought that the one who had made the promise was trustworthy. So it was that there came forth from one man, himself as good as dead, descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sands on the seashore.

Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your belongings and give alms. Provide money bags for yourselves that do not wear out, an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be. "Gird your loins and light your lamps and be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. Amen, I say to you, he will gird himself, have them recline at table, and proceed to wait on them. And should he come in the second or third watch and find them prepared in this way, blessed are those servants. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour when the thief was coming, he would not have let his house be broken into. You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." Then Peter said, "Lord, is this parable meant for us or for everyone?" And the Lord replied, "Who, then, is the faithful and prudent steward whom the master will put in charge of his servants to distribute the food allowance at the proper time? Blessed is that servant whom his master on arrival finds doing so. Truly, I say to you, the master will put the servant in charge of all his property. But if that servant says to himself, 'My master is delayed in coming,' and begins to beat the menservants and the maidservants, to eat and drink and get drunk, then that servant's master will come on an unexpected day and at an unknown hour and will punish the servant severely and assign him a place with the unfaithful. That servant who knew his master's will but did not make preparations nor act in accord with his will shall be beaten severely; and the servant who was ignorant of his master's will but acted in a way deserving of a severe beating shall be beaten only lightly. Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more."

Profession of Faith

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him all things were made. He ascended into Heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and His kingdom will have no end. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

A Note from The Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus said to His disciples: “*Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come.*” (Mark 13:33). To what time is our blessed Savior referring? He is talking about death. Be prepared. Judgement awaits. *Store up treasure in Heaven.* (Matthew 6:19). How? By living a life of faith, hope and charity. Now. Fortunately, praise the Lord, so many Sacred Heart parishioners are doing just that!

St. Drithelm is a witness to these words of Christ. He was a husband and father who lived in England. His life was that of a practicing Catholic. In 693, he fell sick and died. His wife and children were saturated with sorrow. His wife passed the night in tears by his coffin. The next day, just before the procession to his burial, Drithelm rose to life all of a sudden. He sat up and everyone fled the room, except his betrothed. He immediately calmed her down and assured her that it was God who brought him back to life in order to teach people how to be prepared for the day of judgement. He then informed her that he was to have many years more on earth. However, his life would be much different. Then he rose to his feet, in perfect health, and went straight to the local church and prayed for hours and hours.

Drithelm soon told of his tour of Purgatory. “On leaving my body, I was received by a benevolent person, who took me under his guidance. His face was brilliant, and he appeared surrounded with light. He arrived at a large deep valley of immense extent, all fire on one side, all ice and snow on the other; on the one hand braziers and caldrons of flame, on the other the most intense cold and the blast of a glacial wind. This mysterious valley was filled with innumerable souls, which, tossed as by a furious tempest, threw themselves from one side to the other. When they could no longer endure the violence of the fire, they sought relief amidst the ice and snow; but finding only a new torture, they cast themselves again into the midst of the flames.”

“I contemplated in a stupor these continual vicissitudes of horrible torments, and as far as my sight could extend, I saw nothing but a multitude of souls which suffered without ever having repose. Their very aspect inspired me with fear. I thought at first that I saw Hell; but my guide, who walked before me, turned to me and said, ‘No; this is not, as you think, the Hell of the reprobate. Do you know,’ he continued, ‘what place this is?’ ‘No,’ I answered. ‘Know,’ he resumed, ‘that this valley, where you see so much fire and so much ice, is the place where the souls of those are punished who, during life, have neglected to confess their sins, and who have de-

ferred their conversion to the end. Thanks to a special mercy of God, they have had the happiness of sincerely repenting before death, of confessing and detesting their sins. This is why they are not damned, and on the great day of judgment will enter into the Kingdom of Heaven. Several of them will obtain their deliverance before that time, by the merits of prayers, alms, and fasts, offered in their favor by the living, and especially in virtue of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass offered for their relief.” [Rev. Fr. F. X. Schouppe S.J., *Purgatory Explained*, 1893.].


Drithelm returned home from church only to take leave of his family. He declared that he would live only to prepare himself for death, and advised them to do likewise. Then, having divided his property into three parts, he gave one part to his children, another part to his wife, and reserved the third part for almsgiving. Then he was received into a monastery. As a monk he was known for his extreme austerity and his great mortifications. Once, when his fellow monks asked him about his unusual practices, referring to his supernatural experience he answered, “I have seen penances still more astonishing.” Drithelm’s life and death created a profound sensation in England. A great number of sinners, moved by his words and by his example of self-denial, were converted. They recalled the words of Sacred Writ: *Let him pass from the snow waters to excessive heat.* (Job 29:19). Looking back, English Christians recognized that the extraordinary grace given to Drithelm was yet another example of Divine Mercy stirring up a holy fear of sin and judgement in souls that are beloved beyond words.


