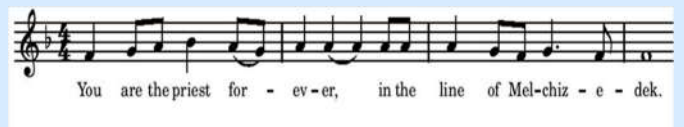

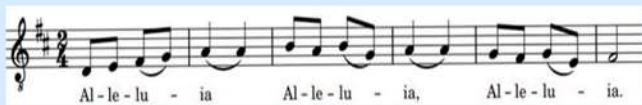

## A Note from The Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

There was good news recently involving people of vastly different ages and backgrounds. Twelve-year-old Gabriel Clark lives in Cumbria, England. He fell in love with woodworking when he was just four years old. "I've always had a real passion for it and I've just taught myself everything I know." Then, he wanted a mountain bike, and so he decided to use his considerable carpentry skills to make handcrafted bowls, sell them, and raise the money needed for the purchase of the bicycle.

Richard, his father (by the way, Happy Father's Day!), wanted to assist. He did so by asking people on Twitter to follow his son's Instagram account. Gabriel quickly went from having 6 followers to 250,000 followers. As a result, Gabriel received 20,000 commissions for his wooden bowls. He would never be able to fill all of those orders. Moreover, at this point, the boy had a change of heart. He decided to put his mountain bike on hold and instead, to use his talent to help others.

He carved one very special bowl: "Gabriel's Bowl for Ukraine." The young carpenter carved two blue and yellow rings into the bowl, which are the colors of the Ukrainian flag. Then, on his fundraising page, he set up a raffle of 14,000 entries. The proceeds were to go to help children in Ukraine. One winner was eventually selected. Her name is Renuka Chapman. She said, "When Gabriel rang me to let me know I'd won the bowl, I was completely overwhelmed—I've never won a single thing before! This bowl will be one of my most treasured possessions. It represents hope, compassion, and kindness ... it will have pride of place in my home."

Gabriel was thrilled with the response to his fundraising. He said, "I'm absolutely blown away by the level of support that my bowl and I have received. I originally hoped to raise £5,000! [He would go on to raise £250,000]. I hope that the money can help *Save the Children* to provide more support to kids who've been impacted by the conflict with things like food, water and a safe place to sleep." Furthermore, he said, "I want to know that I can make other children's lives better by doing a little bit of something in my own life." His mother, Teresa, said, "The main thing about Gabriel, he's got a really, really big heart. He's talented, he's creative, but more than anything, he's got a big heart."

Not only are good things happening among the young. Positive predicaments endure with the elderly. Currently, the two oldest humans on the planet are practicing Catholics. The oldest man is Juan Vicente Pérez Mora, from Venezuela. He prays the Holy Rosary twice a day. Mora was born on May

27, 1909. He recently turned 113 years old. Mora said his secret to a long life is to "work hard, rest on holidays, go to bed early, drink a glass of aguardiente (a strong liquor made from sugarcane) every day, love God, and always carry Him in your heart." He says his family and friends are his most cherished companions and that the greatest thing that he has learned in life is "the love of God, the love of family, and that we must get up early to work."

Mora was the ninth child of 10 born to Eutiquio del Rosario Pérez Mora and Edelmira Mora. When Mora was 5 years old, he started working with his father and siblings in harvesting coffee and sugar cane. Mora served as sheriff in Caricuena from 1948 to 1958. He was married to Ediofina del Rosario García for 60 years. She passed away in 1997. The couple had six sons and five daughters. The family now includes 41 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and 12 great-great-grandchildren. "My Uncle Vicente transmits a lot of peace, tranquility and radiates a lot of joy," his nephew Freddy Abreu said. "He's a person who has a lot to give. He enjoys the simple things in life and is very grateful to God."

The oldest human being in the world is a female: French nun Sister Andre Randon. She was born on Feb. 11, 1904. She is 118 years old. She ministered until she was a hundred and then retired to a retirement home. She continues to enjoy chocolate and a glass of wine every day. When she became the world's oldest person, she admitted that it was a "sad honor," but that she enjoyed being "pampered" by her family.
