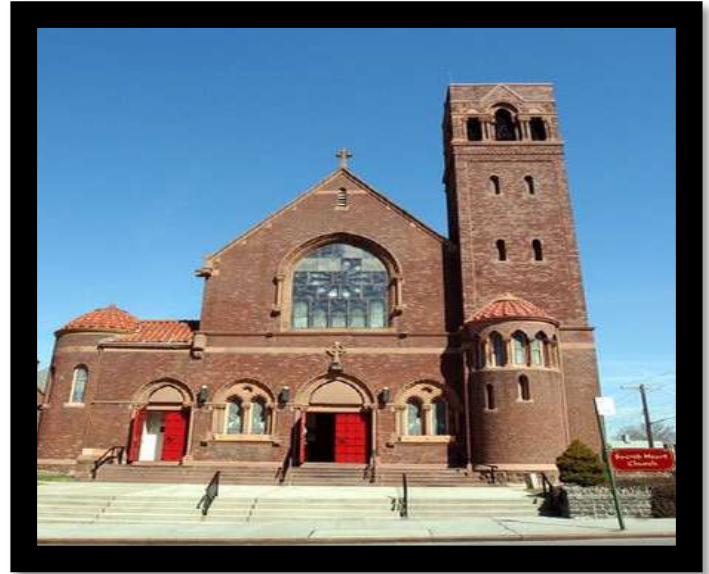

## A Note from The Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The month of November is a special month for the remembrance of the dead, especially at the Holy Altar. Our Lord Jesus Christ (blessed be His Name) *wills that all men be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth.* (1 Timothy 2:4). Therefore, the following true story deserves our attention.

In the year 1629, at Dôle, in France, a woman named Hugette Roy was dying. One morning, at dawn, a young girl dressed in white entered her room. She carried herself in a modest way and asked if the bed-ridden woman would be willing to accept her services and be nursed by her. The sick lady was delighted with the offer. The stranger immediately lighted the fire, approached Hugette, and placed her gently on the bed. She continued to watch by her and serve her like the most competent and caring nurse. Soon, Hugette felt completely cured. In her new-found joy and energetic state, she grew quite curious to know who was it that had nursed her back to health.

The friendly stranger withdrew, saying that she would return in the evening. In the meantime, astonishment spread among her relatives and neighbors. No one spoke of anything in Dôle but this mysterious event. When the unknown visitor returned in the evening, she said to Hugette,

“Know, my dear niece, that I am your aunt, Leonarde Collin, who died seventeen years ago, leaving you an inheritance from her little property. Thanks to the Divine Bounty, I am saved, and it was the Blessed Virgin, to whom I had great devotion, who obtained for me this happiness. Without her I was lost. When death suddenly struck me, I was in the state of mortal sin, but the merciful Virgin Mary obtained for me perfect contrition, and thus saved me from eternal damnation. Since that time, I am in Purgatory, and our Lord permits me to finish my expiation by serving you during fourteen days. At the end of that time, I shall be delivered from my pains if, on your part, you have the charity to make three pilgrimages for me to three holy sanctuaries of the Blessed Virgin.” [Rev. Fr. F. X. Schouppe S. J., *Purgatory Explained*, 1893, p. 30].

Hugette was flabbergasted. Not being able to believe the words of the apparition, and fearing some sort of demonic deception, she consulted her confessor, the Jesuit Father Antony Roland. He advised her to threaten the unknown person with the exorcisms of the Church. However, this threat inspired no fear. Calmly, Leonarde responded that she would not at all mind the prayers of the Church. She said, “They have no power but against the demons and the damned, none whatever against predestined souls, who are in

the grace of God as I am.” (Ibid).

Hugette asked, “How can you be my Aunt Leonarde? She was old and worn, disagreeable and whimsical, whilst you are young, gentle, and obliging?” “Ah, my dear niece,” replied the apparition, “my real body is in the tomb, where it will remain until the resurrection. This one which you see is one miraculously formed from the air to allow me to speak to you, to serve you, and obtain your suffrages. As regards my irritable disposition, seventeen years of terrible suffering have taught me patience and meekness. Know, also, that in Purgatory we are confirmed in grace, marked with the seal of the elect, and therefore exempt from all vice.” (Ibid).

After this explanation, Hugette was convinced. She joyfully received the services rendered by her aunt during the fourteen days designated. She alone could see and hear the deceased, who came at certain hours and then disappeared. As soon as her strength returned, she devoutly made the pilgrimages which were requested of her. At the end of fourteen days the apparition ceased. Leonarde appeared for the last time to announce her deliverance. She was brilliantly radiant in light and oozing with joy. She thanked her niece and promised to pray for her and her whole family. Then she solemnly warned her to always remember the ultimate goal of human existence and, what should be, our top priority: the salvation of our soul.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace, amen.
