

## A Note from The Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Dr. Kathi Aultman changed her mind. She said, “I came to recognize that the innocent victim in an abortion was the baby. Being unwanted was no longer enough justification for me to take the life of a child.” [Kathi Aultman: Why I am No Longer an Abortionist, *focusonthefamily.com*, 16 January 2020].

During her medical residency Dr. Aultman believed that abortion on demand was an issue of women’s rights: the “right to choose.” It was that simple. She was convinced that a woman should have control over her body and not be forced to bear a child she did not want. She also thought that it was wrong to bring unwanted children into an overpopulated world where they might be neglected or abused.

During her residency program she was taught how to perform abortions. After each procedure she was instructed to collect all of the tissue removed during the procedure in order to examine the tissue carefully to account for all the body parts. This would ensure that nothing was left in the patient that might cause infection or bleeding.

Dr. Aultman writes, “At that time a human fetus seemed no different to me than the chicken embryos I dissected in college. I could view them with strictly scientific interest, devoid of the emotions with which I would normally view a baby. I wasn’t heartless ... I had just been trained to compartmentalize my feelings. If I had a patient come in who had experienced a miscarriage or a stillbirth, and she had wanted the baby, then I was distraught for her and empathized with her pain. In my mind, the difference was whether the baby was wanted or unwanted.”

After she obtained her medical license, she worked at a women’s clinic in Gainesville, Florida performing abortions. Her view at the time was that even though the need for the procedure was unfortunate, she was doing something to promote the well-being of women by relieving them of the burden of unwanted pregnancies. Moreover, she was able to earn much more money doing abortions than she could working in an emergency room. Hence, there were certainly economic benefits to this line of work. Furthermore, she enjoyed the technical challenges of the procedure, and prided herself on being really good at what she did. “The only time I had any qualms about performing abortions was when I had my neonatal care rotation and realized that some of the babies I was trying to save in the NICU were around the same age as the babies I was aborting. Ultimately, I was able to rationalize these thoughts and push my reservations aside.”

Dr. Aultman became pregnant during her last year in residency, but continued to do abortions. The first time she returned to the clinic after her delivery, however, she began to change her mind. Three patients led her to the metamorphosis.

“In the first case, I discovered that I had already performed three previous abortions on a girl scheduled that morning. When I protested doing yet another abortion, I was told by the clinic staff that it was her right to use abortion as her method of birth control and that I had no right to pass judgment on her or to refuse to do the procedure. I told them it was fine for them to say that, but that I was the one who had to take the life of the baby. The young woman got her abortion and, despite my urging, refused birth control. The next situation involved a woman who, when asked by a friend if she wanted to see the fetal tissue, replied “No! I just want to kill it.” I felt like saying, What did that baby ever do to you? The third case brought me to tears. The woman was a mother of four who felt like she couldn’t support another child. She cried throughout her entire time at the clinic.”

“Through these three cases, I finally made the emotional connection between fetus and baby. What struck me in particular was the apathy of the first patient and the hostility of the second toward the fetuses inside them – contrasted with the sorrow and misery of the third woman who knew what it was to have a child. I recognized that the innocent victim in all of this was the baby. Being unwanted was no longer enough justification for me to take the child’s life. And that was the end of my abortion career.”
