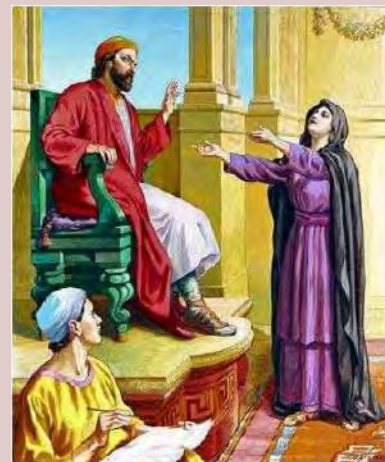
**RESPONSORIAL PSALM PS 34: 2-3, 17-18, 19, 23.**

**R. The Lord hears the cry of the poor.**

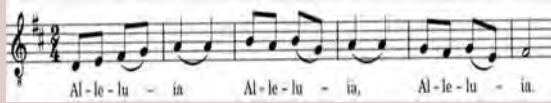
**READING 2 2 TM 4:6-8, 16-18.**

## GOSPEL

Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else. "Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector. The Pharisee took up his position and spoke this prayer to himself, 'O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity -- greedy, dishonest, adulterous -- or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.' But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

### Profession of Faith

Dear Friends of Sacred Heart,

When I visited our school children last week, I told them that I have a rose garden in my pocket. Could you imagine the surprised look on their faces? I asked them to close their eyes, and I took out my rosary beads.

It is true that each time we carry a rosary, we have a rose garden in our pocket. The word “rosary” comes from the Latin word *rosarium* which means “rose garden” or a “garland of roses.” According to our Catholic tradition, the practice of praying the rosary began in 1214 when the Blessed Mother appeared to St. Dominic de Guzman in France. Devotion to the rosary grew rapidly in the following years and centuries. In 1883, a papal declaration set aside the month of October as the month of the Queen of the Holy Rosary. In 1917, the Blessed Mother appeared in Fatima to three young children and asked them to pray the rosary every day for peace in the midst of a time when the world was on the brink of communism.

While the rosary is not found in Scripture, it leads us to better understand and reflect upon the life of Jesus Christ from His Nativity to His Ministry and to His Death and Resurrection. By praying the rosary, we live the life of Jesus through the eyes of Mary, His Mother, and we receive the grace to draw closer to God. St. John Paul II wrote in his apostolic letter entitled *Rosarium Virginis* that “through the rosary the faithful receive abundant grace as though from the very hands of the mother of the redeemer.”

We all treat our mothers so dearly, and so too do we honor Mary, who is our heavenly mother. We embrace devotion to the most holy rosary and to Mary because it is innate in each of us to be close to our mothers.

*The Rosary Crusade* by Fr. Peyton says that *the family who prays together stays together*. Let us pray our rosary in our families so that the bonds that exists among our family members may be deepened through the grace

of God. Our parish family prays the rosary every day at nine o'clock in the morning to express our ardent devotion to the Blessed Mother. I invite you to join us daily before the nine-thirty mass to join in praying the rosary to entrust ourselves to our Blessed Mother Mary.

Whenever I pray the rosary in the morning with the parishioners, I offer every bead of the Hail Mary for each of you that the Blessed Mother will protect and keep you always in the grace of her son, Jesus Christ.

Finally, please respond to the call for volunteers so that you can become a more active part of our parish through a particular ministry or group. Every one of you has a talent to give for the glory of God and the sanctification of our parish family. Using our talents, we have an opportunity to do good for others. Let us use them well, because God has given them to us to be shared.

Our young people and your church need you. Share the light of Christ through the gift of your talents.

May the Blessed Mother continue to spread her mantle of protection over each of you and your families. May God bless and keep you always.
