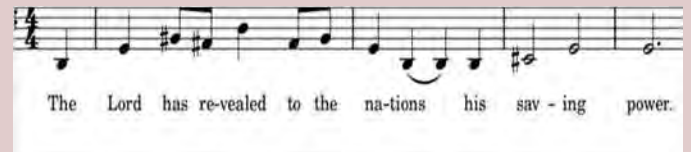

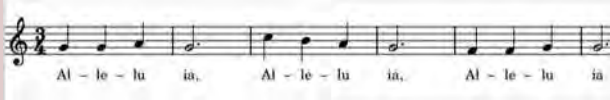
READING 2 2 TM 2:8-13.

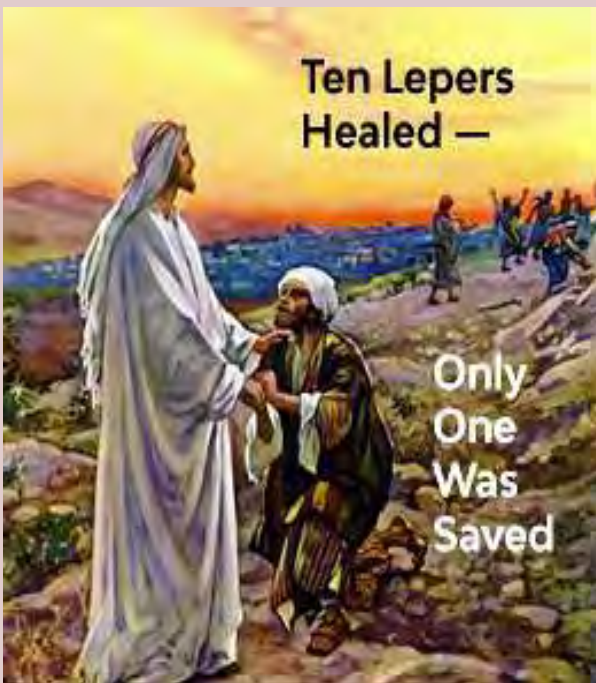


In all circumstances, give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.

A Note from The Pastor

My dear friends of Sacred Heart Parish,

I am happy to have this opportunity to introduce myself to you all.

My name is Fr. Rizalino, the name my mom uses only when she is mad at me. I was born and raised in the north-western part of the Philippines and I emigrated to the United States in 2010. I am usually called Fr. Rhey, a slight variation of the Spanish word (rey) for king. Please understand that I come to you not as king but as a servant of the Catholic community just as Christ the King who came not to be served but to serve. I started my service in America on Staten Island as a parochial vicar in St. Joseph-St. Thomas (2010-2018), Holy Rosary (2018-2019) and Our Lady of Good Counsel and as chaplain at Moore Catholic High School (2019-2022). For the past 12 years of working on Staten Island, I can say that I have covered the whole nine yards.

As I begin my service to you, I humbly ask for your prayers to Jesus whose Sacred Heart beats for all that I may be a true servant who brings all things into the fold of Christ the King. As your priest I will teach you the joy of the Gospel all the while understanding that I continue to be a student who is willing and open to learn from your faith-life journey. I believe each of you has something to contribute from the inspiration of the Holy Spirit who acts in your life.

I express my deepest appreciation to Cardinal Dolan for giving me this opportunity to serve you as administrator while remaining as Chaplain at Moore Catholic High School. My ministry with the young people of the Archdiocese has been for the last three years a tremendous blessing for me. While it is demanding to deal with teenagers (I am sure parents

will agree with me), it is such a worthwhile ministry for they are not just the future of the Church but they are the present Church whose idealism challenges the complacency of the adults.

Both parish and high school ministries make my priestly life meaningful and purposeful for my goal is to strive "to become all things to all" (1 Cor 9:22). By the grace of God the year ahead is going to be filled with joy and excitement as we walk together discovering the many surprises God has in store for us.

I have received such a warm welcome from the parish staff and the few parishioners I have had the opportunity to meet. I look forward to meeting all of you face to face, getting to know your families and listening to your wonderful stories. I appreciate Fr. Eric's support and help in the transition period while I still learn how to navigate the administration of the parish. Please be patient with me as I learn from you the ways and the culture of this beautiful parish.

Please know that you are in my prayers and I request once again that you pray for me to the Sacred Heart of Christ the King.

CCD Registration 22-23: Registration for CCD Classes for the 2022-2023 school year has begun.
